Find out more about the **812P401 Study**

Are you the parent or guardian of a preschool-age (4-5 years of age) child who has problems with **hyperactivity** (e.g. difficulty sitting still, running/climbing in inappropriate situations), **impulsivity**, and **inattention**? If so, your child may be showing symptoms of Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). There is a study medication approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for the treatment of ADHD in persons 6 years of age and older. There is an ongoing study evaluating this medication for the treatment of ADHD in preschool-age children.

Your child may be able to join the 812P401 Study if they:

- Are 4 years 0 months of age to less than or equal to 5 years 9 months of age
- Have an ADHD diagnosis confirmed at Screening Visit
- Have tried non-medication treatment OR have symptoms severe enough to warrant treatment with medication
- Are attending a structured group activity (such as preschool, kindergarten, sports, Sunday school, or childcare) at least 2 days a week during the study

There are other requirements for taking part. The study team will go over the details with you.

Study-related expenses may be reimbursed, and children in the study will receive close study-related medical care throughout the study. Children will receive an ADHD evaluation and physical exam to determine if they are eligible to participate.
